level 1	The student will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • understand words representing objects from familiar routines before developing the ability to name objects • identify perceptual (i.e., characteristic features) and categorical (i.e., adjectives) words describing common people, places, objects, and events • identify familiar people, places, objects, and events • name people and objects in the immediate environment 	With help, “I can” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • say it • point to it • look at it • grab it • smile at it [it = words]

	Learning Goals	Student Success Criteria
level 2	The student will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • identify words describing familiar people, places, objects, and events • will identify words that represent a personal experience • describe an event or personal experience using relevant words and symbols 	With help, “I can” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • look at it • point to it • grab it • smile at it • say it • tell about it [it = words/event/personal experience] [say/tell = gestures, signs, symbols, vocalizations, and/or words]
